Regarding COVID-19 Vaccinations (On-Campus Booster Vaccinations (Third Doses))

To All Students:

On-campus booster vaccinations (third doses) will be provided at the University for students as described below.

If you would like to receive a vaccination, please register using the Online Vaccine Reservation System (information forthcoming).

Future updates about these vaccinations will be posted to the dedicated University vaccination webpage (to be updated as necessary), so please check back regularly for the latest information. (<u>https://www.nagoya-u.ac.jp/info/20210628.html</u>)

Eligible Recipients: Students who received their second dose at least 6 months ago (including new students)

All students are eligible regardless of student status, including non-degree-seeking students.

Students who are not enrolled at Nagoya Institute of Technology as of April 2022 due to graduation or completion of their studies are not eligible. (Please get the vaccination at the municipality where you have your certificate of residence or at your university or workplace).

You must bring a vaccination coupon for the third dose sent by the local government on the day of your appointment.

If you don't have the coupon, vaccinations will be administered to those who can be verified by confirming that 6 months have passed since the second vaccination by means of proof of vaccination (written documents, app, etc.).

Also, please note that the vaccination coupon must be submitted later.

Scheduled Vaccination Period:

April 18 (Mon) - May 17 (Tue), 2022, 12:00-18:00

The vaccination site will be closed on weekends and holidays, including Golden Week (April 29-May 8).

May 14 and 15 are designated as extra days. Depending on reservations and other factors, vaccinations will be available on these days when deemed necessary.

Vaccination Time: 12:00 - 18:00

Vaccination Site: Toyoda Auditorium / Symposion, Nagoya University (Furo-cho, Chikusa-ku, Nagoya)

Vaccine To Be Used: Takeda/Moderna

Vaccination Registration: Online Vaccine Reservation System *The URL will be announced at a later date.

Scheduled Reservation Start Date: April 8 (Fri), 2022

*The reservation start time will be announced along with the URL.

*Spaces are limited, and cancellations will have a significant impact on everyone. We ask in the strongest possible terms that you not cancel your appointment without good reason.

*A call center is scheduled to open on April 1. For inquiries about reservations, handling of vaccination coupons and pre-vaccination screening questionnaires, and other concerns, please contact the call center. The phone number will be announced at a later date.

*Because some people cannot be vaccinated due to physical or medical conditions, and because there is a risk of side effects after being vaccinated, we are not mandating vaccination. You may freely decide whether or not to receive the vaccine.

Please be considerate and do not discriminate against people who have not been vaccinated.

*There has been discussion about the development of acute myocarditis/pericarditis after being vaccinated against COVID-19, but the incidence is much higher after COVID-19 infection than it is after vaccination, and the majority of those who do develop symptoms experience only mild symptoms.

Nevertheless, if you have concerns, it is recommended that you receive the Pfizer vaccine (please contact your local government-run health center or medical institution for information about Pfizer vaccination sites).

*If you experience chest pain, palpitations, shortness of breath, or swelling within four days of being vaccinated, please consult with your doctor. Make sure to tell them that you were recently vaccinated.
