Please see the announcement below for detailed information about on-campus vaccinations for students, faculty and staff.

If you want to receive a vaccination, please register using the online reservation system below. Students, faculty, and staff who hope for the vaccination by the prior vaccination questionnaire, please apply through the web-based reservation system below.

<u>Those who did not hope for vaccination or who did not respond to the questionnaire by the deadline will not be able to make a reservation.</u>

### **Eligible Recipients: Students, Faculty and Staff**

(All students and employees are eligible regardless of student or employee status, including non-degree-seeking students, non-regular employees, etc.)

### Vaccination Period:

<First Dose> July 12 (Mon) - August 8 (Sun), 2021 <Second Dose> August 9 (Mon) - September 9 (Thur), 2021 (excluding August 13 (Fri) - August 16 (Mon))

\*Please make sure you schedule around your final exams and summer intensive courses.

### Vaccination Time: 12:00 - 18:00

(13:00 - 18:00 for the periods July 12 (Mon) - July 15 (Thur) and August 9 (Mon) - August 12 (Thur), 2021)

Vaccination Site: Toyoda Auditorium / Symposion, Nagoya University (Furo-cho, Chikusa-ku, Nagoya)

system.

Spaces are limited, and cancellations will have a significant impact on everyone. We ask in the strongest possible terms that you not cancel your appointment without good reason.

- \*If you have already received your vaccination coupon or are scheduled to receive it soon, <u>we ask</u> that you use the mass vaccination site run by the local government if possible. Please do not make reservations at both the local mass vaccination site and the university vaccination site, as this will delay other people's vaccinations. We ask in the strongest possible terms that you not cancel your appointment without good reason.
- \*Please do not lose a vaccination coupon sent by the local government, as it will be collected when you receive your second dose, or you will be asked to send it in using a return envelope that will be distributed to you at the vaccination site.
